### Rev. Nathaniel Buford

The Rev. Nathaniel C. Buford, 68, 604 S St., died Tuesday, Feb. 18, 1992, in a fire at his home. An autopsy ruled he died of carbon monoxide poisoning due to smoke inhalation and authorities are investigating his death as a homicide.

Funeral services are at 11 a.m. Monday at the Shiloh Baptist Church, Atchison, with the Revs. Claude Webb and William McClen-don officiating. Burial will be at 1:30 p.m. in the Veterans Administration Cemetery, Leavenworth.

Memorial contributions are suggested to the family.

The Rev. Buford was born Oct. 4,

1923 in Millington, Tenn. He had been a resident of Atchison for 30 years. He had been employed at Rockwell International for 25 years, retiring in 1990.

He served in the U.S. Navy during World War II during World War II and was given an honorable discharge at Great Lakes, Ill., in 1947.

The Rev. Buford was a member of the old Mt. Olive Baptist Church and continued his membership to the Zion Baptist Church and became an ordained minister. He was an assistant pastor at the Shiloh Baptist Church, Atchison. Three years ago, he became assistant pastor at the Second Baptist Church of Hiawatha and remained in that capacity until his death.
